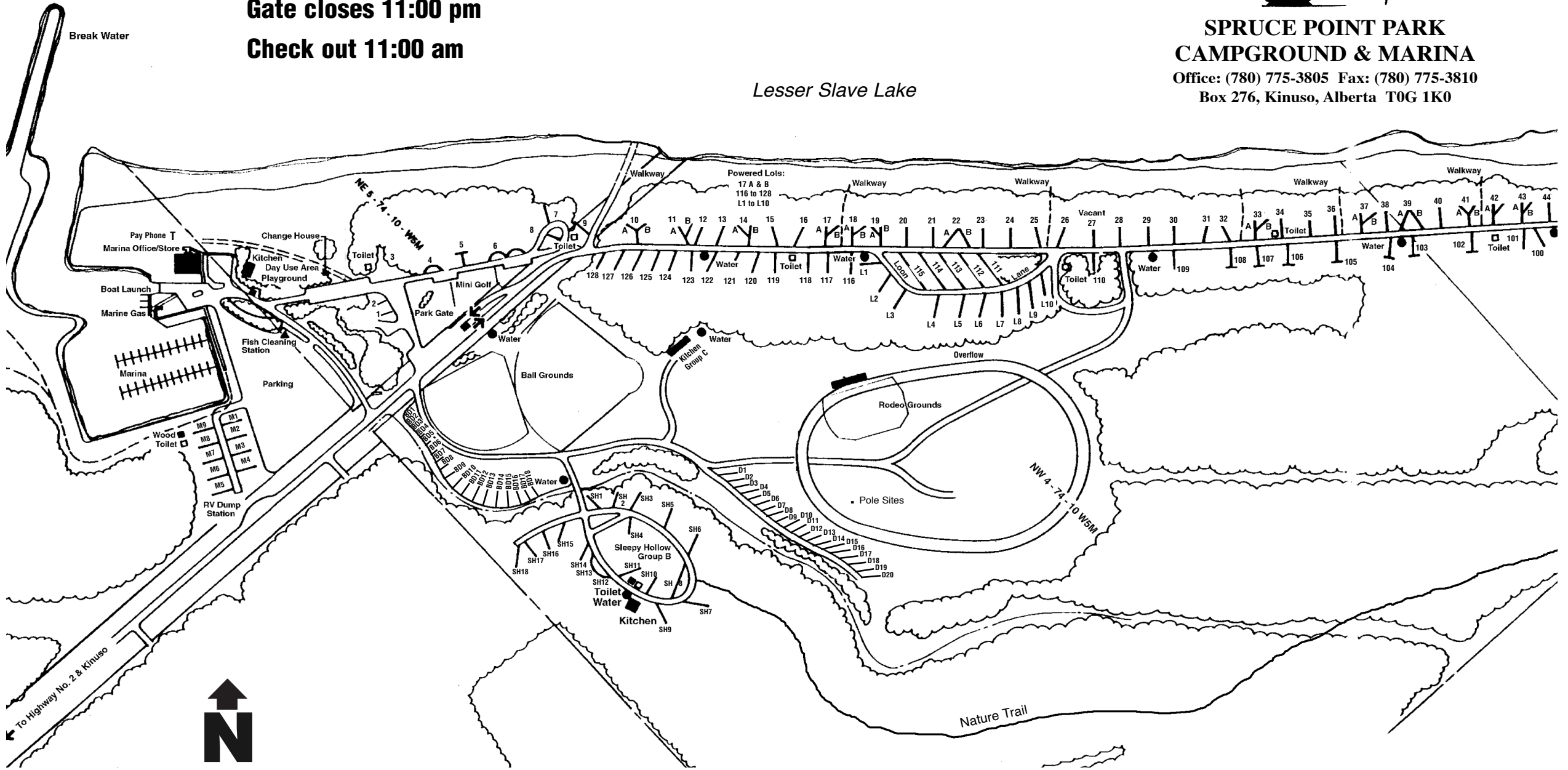

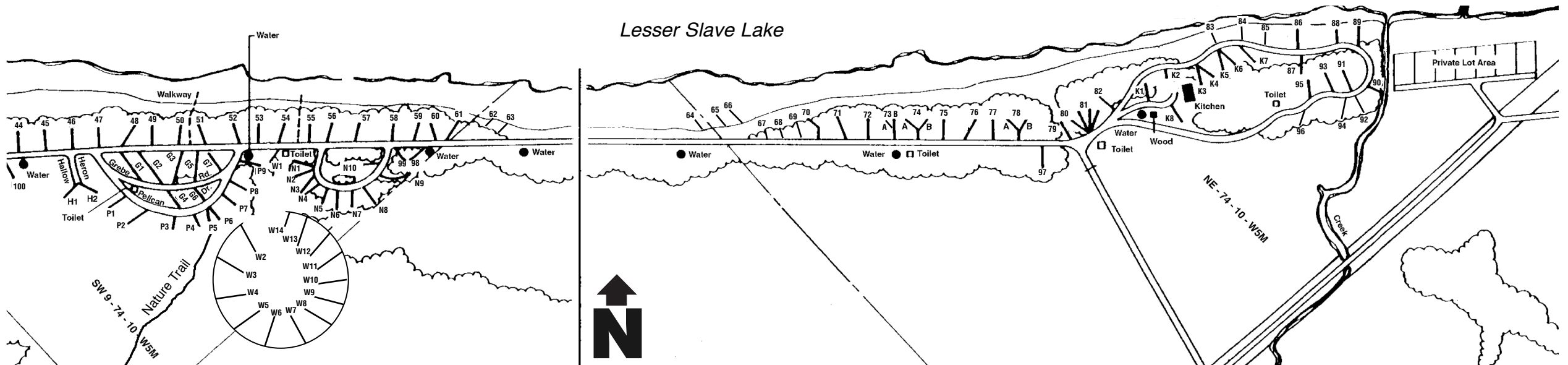

CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

Campsite Check-Out Time is 11:00 am & Check-in time is between 2:00 pm. and 9:00 pm



1. Maximum stay is 14 days on a site.
2. Gates are closed at 11:00 p.m.
3. Quiet time is from 11:00 pm to 8:00
4. No refunds due to weather conditions
5. Speed limit in the park is **10 k/m per hour**
6. Do not leave coolers or valuables unattended.
7. No lifeguard on duty. Attend children at all times.
8. Do not fuel boats in the marina with jerry cans.
9. Cutting trees or burning dead fall is not allowed.
10. Guests must leave the campground by 10:00 pm.
11. You are responsible for picking up after your pets.
12. RV or vehicle washing is not allowed on the property
13. All guests are entitled to the quiet enjoyment of their site.
14. Generators may be operated in the park from 9am to 9pm.
15. Fires allowed only in fire pits provided. Do not leave unattended.
16. Extinguish before retiring. Do not move fire pits.
17. Vehicles not displaying a valid pass will be towed at owner's expense.
18. Bag bottles and cans separately and place beside the garbage barrels.
19. Portable toilets & holding tanks must be emptied at the dump station.
20. Bicycles are allowed on gravel roads only and must not be operated after dusk.
21. Music must be kept at a reasonable level at all times and turned off by 11:00 pm
22. Guests and visitors must be registered at the gatehouse and obtain a parking permit.
23. Pets are not allowed in public buildings, on playgrounds, on the beach or in the water.
24. Put all trash in and do not move garbage barrels located throughout the property.
25. Fish are to be cleaned only at the cleaning station located in the marina parking lot.
26. Hunting and firearms of any kind including air rifles, pellet guns and sling shots are not allowed.
27. Alcoholic beverages are Restricted To Your Site. Any drug activity will be reported to the R.C.M.P.
28. Pets must be attended & kept under control on a leash at all times. (2meter leash, not to expand.)
29. Peddling, selling goods or promoting for profit, personal or otherwise, is prohibited unless written permission is obtained from the Park Board.
30. Sea-doo & water skiers must stay out of swimming & shallows areas, and keep clear of fishermen.
31. All days reserved must be paid for. We only guarantee days that are paid for. We do not hold sites pending weather conditions.
32. Moving fire pits, destroying trees will result in a \$100 vandalism charge and eviction without refund.
